In addition, this technology costs between 1/3<sup>rd</sup> and 1/4<sup>th</sup> of other alternative or renewable energy sources. By enhancing this system, we will also be able to introduce additional fuel sources, such as municipal solid waste, landfill reclamation, and even alternative fuels like scrap tires.
